Brent Fairhead

Bully was actually threatened with being dropped half way during the summer. This was a brilliant motivational tool used by me because he really excelled after Christmas. Put his hand up to open the innings and along with Beats formed a very solid combination but he was never overshadowed. His 48 in the GF was testament to how far he has come this year.

Treve Brown

By his own admission, this season could have been anything for Treve personally. Started the season with a ton and then had numerous starts (read 40's and 50's) but failed to capitalise. Never the less, a very, very solid year and his 62 in the semi ensured that we won that game.

Craig Cole

Funky's best year by a country (Gero) mile. Developed a very good tempo to his innings' and showed improved confidence. His eighty against Leeming whilst suffering the flu was a highlight and typical of his consistent season. Also kept very well until his knees could no longer cope.

Ben Mustard

Finished the season in very solid batting form after he adjusted to batting on carpet. His bowling will only get better the more overs he gets under his belt and this, along with his safe hands in slips, points to him becoming a fine allrounder.

Grant Woodhead

He hit the first ball he faced back over the bowler's head for six. This typifies Woody's approach to batting.

Mick Cooper

Coops deserved his place in the side through sheer number of wickets in third grade. Was always going to be our fourth bowler and probably deserved more overs but was often a victim of circumstance. Vic Strnadica

One thing I hate about being the Captain is the fact that we have to drop players from the team. Vic was very unlucky to be dropped at a time when we were striving to find the right balance for the side. Started the year with a blazing 66 and had some other important innings including 31 not out against Cockburn in a low scoring match. Should not give up on playing A grade.

Ryan McCormack

Ryan had a great year in twos and three and if you look at the stats it may be hard to fathom why he was dropped. Sometimes stats do not tell the true story and I think that Rhino should work harder to cement his spot in A grade next season. His 4 for 20 in the opening innings of the year was a highlight.

4th GRADE CAPTAIN'S REPORT

Bizarre, laughter, crazy, uncontrollable, mad, rewarding. These are just some of the words that describe the 4th grade season for 2001/02. Put these all together properly and we may have achieved the ultimate words "PREMIERSHIP CHAMPIONS". We had a very successful year finishing 31 points on top of the premiership ladder and playing off in two grand finals. We just couldn't put the icing on the cake.

Our season started against Phoenix. After a few phone calls on selection night {as usual} we scraped together a team that looked very competitive on paper. We bowled Phoenix out for 72 runs. Vince Cross reaped havoc up the top of the order to claim 4/19. I cleaned up the rest to record my best figures for the season of 6/23. 2nd game was against Southern Districts. Bowling first, we dismissed them for 204. Vince Cross taking 3/66 and I took 4/56. John Middleton and Phil Swift put on 85 for the 1st wicket, which was their best partnership for the year. Middo made 40 while Swifty ended up with 51. From 0/85 to 3/106 the game was in the balance. John Olczyk and myself put on a unbroken partnership of 139 to end the day on 3/245. Olly got 88n.o. and I was on 47n.o. 2 from 2.

3rd and 4th games were against Hilton Park and Kenwick. In both games we played with 9 players. To win both games how we did was a great achievement. Against Hilton Park we bowled them out for 65. Myself taking 6/30 while Olly took 2/9. We replied with 174. Jason Hof making a composed 52n.o. We then had them 3/121 in the 2nd innings. David Vass producing a superb bowling spell to have the figures of 1/15 from 5 overs and then moving like a "CAT CHASING A BIRD" in the outfield to take a great catch.

In the Kenwick game we batted 1st and made 186. This was at Webber which could have been about 230-240 at any other ground. Brett 'THE LORD' Magee made 42. Then John Olczyk and John Lansbury put on 71 to get us to a good total. Lansbury made 35 and Olly made 52. We bowled them out for 71. Olly bowled well to finish with 4/27 and I chimed in with 3/7. We put them back in and gave nearly every one a bowl. They finished with 4/214. Four games 4 wins. Time for the one day games..

We won 6 out 7 one day games with the only loss against Kelmscott before Christmas.
