However, as a club we did have teams in 3 of the 5 possible Grand Finals for the year and managed to grab 2 premierships for the club, so a pretty good result overall.

As the Captain of the A grade team I had some terrific support from people around the club, whom I would like to publicly thank here:

### Off Field Leadership

**Peter Cromwell** – Peter threw himself into the A Grade Manager role (whilst also holding the VP role at committee level as well). Peter is a fantastic person to have around the group and was committed 110% to anything that was asked of him. ### On Field Leadership

I have no problems with admitting that for a lot of the year I was not the one making the decisions on the A grade field this year. I was very fortunate to have a fantastic group of senior players who just stood up and helped with ideas and support on the field. As a bowler it is difficult to remain focused at all times (especially whilst bowling) and these guys really stood up for me. A massive thank you to Blake Miller, Daniel Johannessen, Nick Siave, Chris Siave and Ben Mustard who helped to make all the critical decisions on the field...whilst I took any credit for anything that went well or contributed to our success. They say behind every great man is a great woman, well behind every great captain is a group of legendary senior players!

### Player mentions

I'll give a quick critique of those players who contributed to the 2019 EFCC A grade team.

**Ben Mustard** - A 200 game LEGEND of EFCC. Ben is someone who gives everything he has, which was never more evident than the 1 Day final when he batted through making a 104 not out and then also taking the field for the majority of the 40 overs in blistering heat. Ben had a fantastic year scoring 518 runs at an average of 37. He is a true gentleman and highly respected amongst the SMCA competition. Thanks for involving Charlie Michael as well...Charlie is in good hands for the future!

**Nick (Fridge) Siave** - A giant of our game and another who always gives 110% for the Bullsharks. Nick had a splendid year finishing second in the A grade Association medal. Nick scored 308 runs at an average of 28 and took 26 wickets (the most in EFCC in A grade). Nick is also highly respected within the SMCA community and he is a pleasure to have in and around our club.

**Blake Miller** - Blake is by far the best keeper in our Association. He is another player who provides 110% effort at all times and will do anything to help his side to win. Blake is a shining example of training commitment of which many players could take a "leaf out of his book". Blake scored 258 runs for the year at an average of 18.43 and took 26 catches. Blake undertook the VC role this year and did a fantastic job not losing a game whilst filling in for the absent captain.

**Daniel (Puppy) Johannsen** - Pup under took a role on the leadership group this year which I am sure opened his eyes to a few things experienced when leading a group of men. Dan had a successful year as well making 218 runs with an average of 19.82. Dan played a pivotal role in our 1 Day GF win with a fantastic swashbuckling 61 that helped to set us up for the win. Pup also took 1 wicket this year and was probably under bowled in reality.

**Dan Allsworth** - Dan has fulfilled many roles over time for EFCC. He was one of only 2 left hand bats in our team this year and proved to be a potent batsman when given the chance. Dan's opportunities were somewhat limited this year, but he still managed to score 207 runs at an average of 17.25. He also played a pivotal role with the ball taking 11 wickets at an average of 29.45.

**Chris (Psych) Siave** - As our number 1 spinner, Psych did not disappoint again this year. After a stellar year last year, he was probably starved of opportunity and thus did not get a chance to really shine in the 2019 season. Chris still managed to score 203 runs at an average of 18.45 and take 22 wickets at an average of 23.05. Chris also took 8 catches for the season. Chris is another guy who gives everything to the club and is well respected within the SMCA competition.

**Greg (Barrel) Beresi** - Barrel returned part way through the season and was a welcome inclusion to the side. He played some pivotal games in the middle stages making a solid 195 runs for the season from 9 innings at an average of 27.86. Greg did not get a bowl this year (for good reason 😊). Here's hoping Barrel will be available for the 2020 season.

**Luke Strnadica (Stretch)** - As someone who stands out in a crowd, Luke also impressed in our team. He scored 175 runs at an average of 21.88 and also managed to take 1 wicket with limited bowling opportunities. At 6 foot 8 Luke provided an impenetrable wall when fielding at covers and took the most catches (11) in the team outside of our keeper Blake Miller. Luke also hit a large and memorable six into the river in the 1 Day GF. The boys on 91.3 Sport FM certainly enjoyed it!

**Dasun Weeraratne** - Dasun was a new addition to the club this year. He was super impressive in the pre-season smoking just about every ball in the indoor nets. Dasun is a classic "Benjamin Button" who moved like a 25-year-old despite the 40 year old body. A true gentleman who unfortunately fell out of form and luck in the middle of the year and probably underperformed to his own and our expectations. We hope Dasun will be able to turn his fortunes around next year.

**Mason Gillespie** - Mason offers a lot to the team as a very mobile player (unlike many of us). Mason scored 72 runs through some limited opportunities. Mason continues to improve and show his capabilities and we are looking forward to Mason continuing to commit and show his consistency in future years.

**Gayan Fernando** - Gayan was another new addition this year and showed us early what he was capable of bowling a spell of 19 overs straight in an early game. G took 17 wickets for the year and was again probably starved for opportunities across the season. A fantastic effort from G considering he came to the game each week after working through most of the night.

**Sam Kelsey** - Sam is another 110% player. He always gives all that he has and will do whatever is required for the team or the club. Sam had a fantastic start to the year taking a "6 fa" early and racing to 13 A grade wickets in the first 3 games. Sam then was dropped to the second team and played most of the year in that team (maybe unfairly based on his performance). A great contributor to the EFCC and the competition.
