1st Grade Captain's Report

"East Fremantle Cricket Club - First Grade PREMIERS"

It will bring a smile to my face for a lifetime whenever I recall our club's premiership celebrations on Sunday the 25th of March 2012. The laughter, the tears, the hugging, the back slapping, the hours spent recalling every wicket and every run of our grand final victory, the nudie run, the multiple renditions of "roll 'em, bowl 'em", the packed club of current and past players and supporters partying into the early hours and how some of our club's best were able to stop traffic.

We started the season full of promise and opportunity; we ended the season with the ultimate glory and celebration. In between was a whole lot of hard work and commitment that enabled us to peak at the business end of the season and perform at our best for two very memorable finals.

Our semi-final against CBC was a game that the records will show as an easy victory, however there were many moments that CBC threatened to take control of the game but as a team we stood up to win the key moments. The first occurred after we won the toss and elected to bat and found ourselves in a very precarious position of 3/24 with CBC full of confidence. Up stepped Dan Allsworth with a chanceless hundred in the most pressured situation. Dan and I were able to swing the momentum back in our favour with a 142 run partnership with Dan's amazing knock being the key contribution.

We then lost three quick wickets so the game was again evenly poised at 6/186 with us needing our lower order to finish off the job. As has been the case all season, they didn't let us down with contributions from Rod Sammut, Chris Siave, Chris Leatherday and Nick Siave, we finished with a very impressive 283.

We set about defending our score on day two with plenty of enthusiasm, which quickly turned to deep concern when CBC had raced along to a comfortable 1/169. With nine wickets in hand and needing 115 off 25 overs CBC were in the box seat. We needed something special and we needed it quick, and that's exactly what we got from Mark Natale who had been under bowled all season and Dan Allsworth who had never bowled all season. Mark finished with outstanding figures of 5/16 and Dan capped off his superb game on the big stage with 3/18. Between them both they completely brought CBC to their knees to bowl them out for 198.

Around came our season finale. What we all play for, but many of us never get to achieve. A chance to win a premiership at our home ground in front of a large crowd. God's Country was looking its best with marquees and spectators everywhere. The car parks were full and there was plenty of interest from the local East Fremantle community who could have done with a cross walk for safe navigation across Preston Point Road.

We were up against Cockburn who had beaten us in four previous encounters. Again we won the toss and elected to bat first. We lost key

wickets early and at 3/50 the game could have gone either way. We needed another big game performance when up stepped Ben Mustard, just when we needed him. In true Mustard style he took the attack up to Cockburn with a match winning 66. Along with very important contributions from Elliot Lawrie and Chris Leatherday we finished up with 184. This score was well below what we wanted but certainly a score that if we did everything right we could defend.

Creating and taking early chances was going to be the key and that is exactly what we did. The pace and accuracy in Ed's first spell was a massive big game performance with him taking 3 wickets in his opening spell. The tone he set was mirrored by all of our bowlers on this very memorable day with Chris Leatherday, Hugh Norcross and Nick Siave combining for our best bowling performance of the season on the biggest stage to bowl out Cockburn for a miserly 71 runs. An unbelievable performance.

We were very consistent with our performances all season and our finals performance was a direct reflection of the confidence that we built in ourselves leading up to our finals campaign. The reason why I believe we were the best TEAM in 2011/12 is because:

1. We were a team that put our team performance before our own individual success.
2. We were a team that clearly understood and believed in our game plan.
3. We were a team that prepared better than our opposition. We knew more about opposition player strengths and weaknesses than they knew about ours.
4. We were a team that did the hard yards at training and on Saturdays. We were hungry for success.
5. We were a team that enjoyed each other's company, respected each other's personality, appreciated each other's contribution and celebrated each other's success.

With this representing our TEAM culture, combined with these outstanding individual contributions, it is no surprise we achieved something so special:

Greg Beresi – Over 600 runs for the season including a club record 160 not out against Kardinya

Dan Allsworth – Over 500 runs for the season including a ton in a pressure semi final

Mark Natale – Over 500 runs for the season including a ton against Riverton along with 14 wickets for the season including a crucial 5/16 in our semi final

Ben Mustard – Nearly 400 runs for the season including a match winning 66 in the grand final

Elliott Lawrie – 31 wickets and nearly 200 runs for the season including a man of the match performance of 3/22 with the ball and 36 runs with the bat in the grand final

Chris Leatherday – 34 wickets earning him the association bowling award and including a season best of 6/14 along with nearly 200 runs with the bat

Hugh Norcross – 24 wickets for the season along with being the best #11 batsman in the comp

Nick Siave – 17 wickets for the season including 5/53 against Armadale

Chris Siave – 11 wickets including a hat-trick against Leeming and 173 runs with the bat

Rod Summut – Over 200 runs for the season plus 10 catches and two run outs from just nine games

Paddy Vallence – Nearly 200 runs for the season including 55 against Riverton

Being the first grade captain of a club with such a long history is a real privilege. Being the captain of a first grade premierships side is a real honour. I would like to thank Vic Strnadica, Victor Kostopoulos, Campbell Youngson and the committee for the confidence they showed in me and for all the support and encouragement provided throughout the season.

I would also like to thank my mum, Barbara Kelly and Paddy's mum, Mrs Vallence for their much appreciated assistance with afternoon teas.

Next season the club has an opportunity to achieve something that is very rare – consecutive premierships flags. We already have the tried and tested BLUE PRINT to success. All we need is the same attitude, hunger and commitment to success that we had this season.

One Day A Captain's Report

Second is not success; but by making the grand final, the ODA team exceeded its collective capability and can be proud that it represented the East Fremantle Cricket Club in the manner it would want – strong competitive spirit, good sportsmanship and the best afternoon teas in the competition.

Though, the tea at Willetton on 26 November 2011 did challenge the team to raise the bar higher, and it did.

Rounds 1 – 5. The season started very well with a 5-0 record thanks to contributions from Rod Sammut, Casey Young, Brad Franklin and Peter Witcomb. Casey was consistently turning the strike over and accumulating high scores, whilst Rod Sammut was blistering anything short to all boundaries. Against Leeming, Rod had gone out to open the batting, just as one Leeming supporter was chatting to the EFCC non-batters about how they had been punished by a Southern Districts player for 136 the week before, and that it wasn't fair that a player of that calibre be playing in ODA; The EFCC players agreed non-committedly, and then watched Rod Sammut dispatch 14 fours and 7 sixes - oops; and the bells were ringing in everyone's heads that maybe Rod was too good for One Day A's.

Round 6. An undermanned team was then thrashed in round six at Gwynne Park, as Armadale piled on 370 runs in 40 overs, and no more about that incident was to ever be mentioned.

Rounds 7 – 10. Post-Armadale, the team regrouped for a few good wins in succession, including beating Cockburn at Goodchild Reserve with nine players including two women; special thanks to Karl Rainnie for recruiting wife Leanne and friend Taneale Paschelle for the game with the highlight being sixteen year old Taneale cover driving Cockburn's fastest bowler for four and also taking the wicket of Cockburn's number three batsman. After a forfeit from Fremantle in Round 10, the ODA's went into the Christmas break with a 9-1 record, and sat on top of the ladder.

Rounds 11 – 16. Post-Christmas, Casey Young took over the team for the road trips to Mundijong and Riverton, with superb performances by Ben Norton and emerging fast bowler Daniel Kostopoulos for one win and one loss. On debut, Ben Tasker took to the Willetton attack for 79 with Craig Cole settling back into the ODA team with an all-round 72 and 3/14. At this time Casey Young had taken over the glove work and proving to be a natural, taking all that came his way and adding significant pressure to the opposition batsmen by standing up to the stumps for medium pace bowling. In round 16, the team lost comprehensively to Southern Districts, the ODA's post-Christmas record was 2-4 and it risked losing a top four position.

Rounds 17 – 18. The team reconsolidated and returned to competitive and disciplined cricket and the results quickly turned back to pre-Christmas form, with strong victories in rounds 17, 18 and the semi-final. In round 17, Craig Cole hit a characteristic 96 including 8 fours and 8 sixes to contribute to a victory against Cockburn at Henry Jeffrey Oval; In round 18, Ben Norton demolished the Leeming top order to have all five wickets with four overs left

to bowl, and on track for a 10 wicket haul, before asking to be rested because he was tired. Set a total of 103 to chase, Scott McIntosh made short work of it by hitting 48 in short time to ensure the victory and third place finish on the ladder.

Semi Final. The ODA team was left with nine qualified and available players. Two subs required, and clubmen John Brown and DJ Jocelyn stepped in to assist. **Sat 10 March, 11:30am**, Jimmy Tate returned the call and headed straight for Bruce Lee Oval; **11:35am**, Karl Rainnie phoned in to advise that wife Leanne was heading to the beach to pick up son Josh Martin, and the team had 11.

EFCC won the toss via the power of persuasion, and elected to bat. At 3/2, the team were in some bother, but Craig Cole played a disciplined innings to backbone two partnerships to get the team to 137, then six wickets fell for 16 and EFCC had posted a defendable 153. The bowling team and keeper Casey Young turned up. Scott McIntosh bowled fast, Nick Bonner bowled slow, and Casey Young took four great catches behind the stumps and Southern Districts were 4/12, and broken. Ben Norton and Craig Cole finished off the job, bowling the opposition out for 78, and Casey Young took five catches in a great effort.

Grand Final. Josh Martin couldn't play, leaving the team one short on the day. Thankfully, at short notice, Mick O'Neill agreed to make his season debut for ODAs, in the grand final at Gwynne Park. EFCC won the toss, elected to bat, and were promptly 2/1. Scott McIntosh, Nick Bonner and Craig Cole were all out to excellent catches, and the team were bowled out for 71. Armadale batted semi-patiently, EFCC dropped five catches, and Armadale reached the total after 20.3 overs and deserved the premiership.

...and finally, some famous East Freo yarns...

- Former player and life member Sid Thomas (now deceased) was given the nickname "Claw" – it was reported that his hands were twice the size of any other man!
- In a match between East and South Fremantle, South Fremantle only had 3 players in attendance (the two opening batsmen and the number 11) due to a football scratch match scheduled for the same day. After winning the toss, East Fremantle captain Les Capes sent South Freo in to bat...at the end of the first day, openers Charlie Tyson and Tony Parentich had batted through the day to be 0/290
- 1st Grade using four new balls in the 1980/81 grand final, when CBC made a massive 498. Bowling figures included: Des Hoare 76-26-2-121, Hayes 50-17-1-110, Stuart Cole 44-11-0-96
- 1982/83 – Brad McCaughan reached a century in 55 minutes – he ended on 130, including six 4's and sixteen 6's!
- 1983/84 – Tony Miguel made 94 and took 3/37 in his first game for the club
- 1990/91 – East Fremantle became an incorporated club and ran its own bar for the first time
- 1991/92 – On the same day but in different grades, twins Graeme and Greg Howard both took the exact same figures – 5/37 off 18 overs
- 1996/97 – Coming in at 2/7 as a nightwatchman, Greg Terpsis (the usual number 10) joined Jason Hof to record a club record partnership for any wicket of exactly 300 – Terpsis scoring 113 and Hof a then club record of 184
- 1997/98 – In the last qualifying game of the season before eventually going on to win the premiership, 2A's went to tea with openers Michael Jenkins on 101* and Scot Mathews on 5*! Jenkins finished with 134 in an opening stand of 165
- 1998/99 – In a 3rd Grade match against Gosnells, Steve Strnadica went in at 5/67 and was out for a belligerent 165 to take the team total to 391 all out
- 2001/02 – The club scored more than 1,500 runs in one weekend across all grades with the top three sides finishing as minor premiers. East Fremantle won the club championship for the first (and only) time, all five sides made the finals, four of them made grand finals, but sadly no premierships were won
- 2004/05 – Clint Testa smashed 215 not out for the 'Boozehags' in 6A's to claim the club's highest individual score. That's right - in a 40-over one dayer. It surpassed Steve Beatty's 197 in 2A's in 2000/01
- 2006/07 – After more than 20 years of senior cricket, life member Paul "Choppa" Lyons finally played in his first premiership, in One Day A's
- 2007/08 – East Fremantle tied the 1st grade premiership with Phoenix
- 2009/10 – Hugh Norcross and Blake Lawrie batted in a final wicket partnership to win the last game of the season against Willetton Crows and save 1st grade from possible relegation
- 2011/12 – East Fremantle won just its third 1st grade premiership since the Second World War, by its biggest margin, 113 runs. The 1987/88 grand final was won by one run, 2007/08 was a tie
