

#### PRESIDENT'S REPORT

#### Back to Back baby!!!!

What a year it has been! A season that saw our First-grade side win back to back two day flags as well as compete in the one day Grand Final. Over the past three seasons our top side has had a look at 4 out of the 6 available grand finals, winning 3 premierships from those 4 GF's. What an outstanding effort!

A result I believe from a combination of things:

- 1) A belief in our club and the structure we have created to allow our Cricket Department to recruit players through the off season rather than leaving recruiting until the new season starts.
- 2) The introduction of high-quality players into our club over the past three seasons. A good portion of the success of the club must be attributed to the on field (and off field presence) of our three contracted players across this period in Jim Allenby, Haydan Morton and Ben Scotson.
- 3) The support our players get from the cricket department and committee in providing an environment where cricket is enjoyable and fun. Cricket clubs need cricket equipment and a supportive environment, and our club is good at providing that.
- 4) The ongoing support of our sponsors. This is invaluable to keep our costs low, our opportunities to support our players high and to provide the environment that we do. THANK YOU TO ALL SPONSORS!

#### **TEAM BY TEAM ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS**

#### **FIRST GRADE**

The First-grade team had an exceptional year playing in both Grand finals, taking out the minor premiership, winning the flag and fundamentally dominating the competition for the vast majority of the season. It took a village to achieve this with some 26 players taking to the field across the season. Thank you to all of those players who were part of the winning formula this year.

Stand out performances in this team included:

- 1) Haydan Morton 516 runs, 43 wickets, 16 catches and Jim Mckenna medallist for SMCA. In addition, Haydan scooped a range of medals and trophies from the club including:

Honorary mentions must also go to Elliott Lawrie, James Miguel, Ben Scotson, Kai Morgan, Chris Siave, Ned Sorrell who all had moments in the sun and contributions that helped the side have such a dominate season.

The season saw 4 centurions in Haydan Morton 103 n/o, Jim Allenby 117 and 120 n/o, Luke Strnadica 125 and 119 n/o and James Miguel 124.

It also had 4 bowlers to take 5 or more wickets including Haydan Morton 7/6, Ned Sorrell 5/77, Luke Strnadica 5/41 and Michael Carmody 7/57.

#### **THIRD GRADE**

This team had a battle all year with getting players on the park. Hats off to both Kai Morgan and Ryan Jones who helped to get this team out on the ground all year. The season ended with a 5<sup>th</sup> place overall and 4 wins, but it was really a struggle across the season to find motivated players in this area.

To the 52 different men that played for this team across the year.....THANK YOU. The club could not have been successful in the team above without your contribution.

Stand out performances in this team included:

- 1) Jye Mclaughlin fairest and Best (back-to-back) with 220 runs, 14 wickets and 3 catches.
- 2) Danial Johannessen batting aggregate and average in third grade.

#### **ONE DAY A**

One could say that the team suffered from a premiership hangover. A few players from previous season did not play and consistency was again an issue for this team with 57 players taking to the field for the season.

An overall 5th spot on the ladder at the end of the year meant we were close but not close enough. A huge thank you to Sam Kelsey who has captained this team for the last 4 seasons and has also been heavily involved in player availability on a week-by-week manner which has cost him about 3 years of his life on the phone!! Thank you Sam!

Stand Out performances in this team include:

- 2) Neil Mullally winning the batting average award with 17.58.
- 3) Murray Eastaugh winning the batting aggregate award at 222 runs.
- 4) Sam Kelsey winning the bowling aggregate award with 26 wickets.

We also had Sam Kelsey with 5/18, Cam Leehane with 5/42 across the season and Ben Mustard making 131 not out.

#### **ONE DAY E**

Another 5<sup>th</sup> spot on the ladder for the club. A season that could have had so much more.....but that's cricket! ODE were so close as well but again fell short due to inconsistent player availability and being on the wrong side of the close games. A total of 37 players took the field for this team across the season. A total of 9 wins and some fantastic performances from some senior players.

Stand out performances included:

#### The William "Billy" Doig Perpetual Trophy

Awarded to the player at the East Fremantle Cricket Club with the best bowling figures for the season in any grade.

The perpetual trophy was suggested by Sam Kelsey in the season 2023/2024 and was gratefully accepted on behalf of his and the Doig family by Paul Lyons.

Below is the speech presented by Paul at the annual wind up, held on Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2024.

#### A personal perspective from Paul Lyons – EFCC Life member on his grandfather

William Wallace Doig.

Hi everyone, to those who don't know me, I'm Paul Lyons, and on behalf of the Lyons and Doig families I would like to thank Sam Kelsey and the Committee for honouring my late grandfather William Wallace (Bill) Doig with the naming of this Perpetual Bowling Trophy.

My grandad Bill Doig in 1936 had what he described as a "day out" against the workers club, with match figures of 20 wickets for 21 runs.

In the first innings he took 10 for 15, and in the second innings he took 10 for 6 runs, including a hat trick! All 20 wickets were bowled! Bill also top scored with 40 not out which was 3 runs short of the oppositions total match score!

Bill Doig was an all rounder winning the club batting averages multiple times along with the association average of 61.5 runs in the 1930/31 season. Bill Doig was inducted in the East Fremantle Cricket Club pre - 1980's team of the century in 1998.

I asked my grandad (who passed away peacefully in October 2003 at the age of 91) why he played cricket at East Fremantle, and he said all East Freo footballers who wanted to keep fit in the off season played cricket at "Easts". East Fremantle Football Club was formed in 1897 and he said they were called the "blue and whites". The East Fremantle Cricket Club was founded directly after the footy season being 1897/1898. Looking back as a kid when I started playing cricket at East Fremantle in the mid 1980's, we had a big contingent of former East Freo footballers playing – Peter Stephen, Donny Lang, Spriggy, Des Hoare, Sarich, Vercs and Les Capes and there may have been more?

My grandad was part of the remarkable Doig family with 17 Doig's playing WAFL footy. The Fremantle Dockers honouring their football and Fremantle heritage by naming their Fairest and Best "The Doig Medal". Grandad told me many stories as a kid, one being he played in a derby at Fremantle oval where 8 Doig's played in that game, He said most of the Doig's played for the "blue and whites" but a few for "souths", and there was always a fierce rivalry and that both teams played at the same ground.

My great grandad John Doig, who was my grandad's (William Wallace Doig's) father was one of 5 brothers that played for East Fremantle Football Club. John Doig played in the inaugural game for East Fremantle. He played 224 games and in a record 9 premierships.

My grandad (like most people in those early years) had a tough life. He lost his dad when he was 6 years old. His older brother Norman was 7, and the youngest Edgar was only 4. In World War 1 great

grandad, John Doig died in action in Belgium at the age of 40. Grandad said his mum was a remarkable woman, raising the 3 boys by herself.

In 2015, with my wife Natalie and daughter Taneesha we visited my great grandad's (John Doig's) Menin Gate Memorial, at Ypres, Flanders in West Belgium, where he died in battle. We laid a poppy flower on his memorial plaque on behalf of the Doig and Lyons families. They played the Last Post and held a service at 6pm (as they do every night) It was very emotional.

Theres a photo in the glass cabinet at East Fremantle Cricket Club of the back-to-back premiership teams my grandad played in, 1932/33 and 1933/34. East Fremantle Cricket Club only had one team back then. In that photo is:

- my grandad William Wallace Doig, 23 years old and played 62 games for East Fremantle Football Club and kicked 47 goals, playing on a wing.
- His older brother Norman Doig, 24 years old and played 138 games for East Fremantle Football Club as well as a season at Essendon Football Club.
- The youngest brother Edgar Doig who played 14 games for East Fremantle Football Club but died tragically before they won their second cricket premiership in 1934 from a work accident. He was only 21.
- Also playing was my grandad's cousin, 21-year-old George Doig, he was a full forward. Grandad told me the story how East Fremantle Football Club went to watch George (18 years old at the time) as he had been "playing ok". The game was in a south suburban footy match against Palmyra. George kicked the whole score, points and goals of 26 goals and 20 points. Palmyra kicked 7 goals. East Fremantle Football Club signed him up and in his first game he kicked 9 goals and 106 in his first season. Becoming the first player to kick 100 goals plus in a WAFL season and six times he was the WAFL leading goal scorer. He went on to be East Fremantle's highest ever goal scorer, 1103 goals in 202 games (average 5.46 per game) he kicked over 100 goals for 9 consecutive seasons! Grandad said he only kicked four goals on his (George's) wedding day and they lost!! George Doig also captained and coached at East Fremantle Football Club.
- Also in the photo is my grandad's brother-in-law (my nana's brother), Bill Butler who also played in the back-to-back cricket premierships.

So East Fremantle Cricket Club has always been a family club back then, as it is now. With the Strnadica's, Olczyk's, Renouf's, Miguel's, Lawrie's, Sorrell's, Morgans etc and now with great links to The Melville Football Club as well as the East Fremantle Sharks.

William Doig was a remarkable man on the field, but even more of a champion at home. To Marylyn and Graeme Doig (my mum and uncle) he was a loving Dad. To Julie and Aaron Doig, (my cousins) Greg and Linda (Myself), Dionne and Angelie Lyons (my sibling's) he was a gentle caring and loving Grandad. A true, kind family man who never raised his voice. We were so lucky to have grandad in our lives.

Its fitting that there are similarities with the inaugural winner of the Williams Wallace Doig Trophy, presented to the player with the clubs best bowling figures (in any grade). Coming off back-to-back 1<sup>st</sup> Grade premierships, leading from the front and just starting his own family journey. With the sensational figures of 7 wickets for only 6 runs, I announce our A grade Captain, Haydan Morton as the inaugural winner of the prestigious 2024 William Wallace Doig perpetual Trophy and medal.

Congratulations Haydan.

Our move to Thursday night-only training has proven successful, with impressive attendance even on those scorching days over 40 degrees. A huge thank you to everyone who consistently showed up.


A big shout-out to Haydan and Jim for your cricket wisdom. Your support has made my job much easier and played a big part in leading our First Grade to another successful season.

#### FIRST GRADE REPORT

#### Brief summary: One Day Captain Jim Allenby.

Having missed out on making the One day GF in 2022/23 season, it was important for us to get back to winning ways this season. After a short but intense pre season with new coach Chade, and myself and Haydan coming in as split captains for the 2023/24 season, we agreed we needed to start the season well with 4 one days games in a row to begin. We also agreed as a group that we should look to assign specific roles to players so they could work on focussed areas for the one-day competition. This was agreed that it would not only help our performance this year in one day cricket, but also set up the younger group of players for success in 2 day cricket and for the following years.

Of course, the same applied to our more mature (in age) players and I was delighted with the buy-in from the club legends and life members still playing. The top performers, in terms of stats, in one day cricket this year were:

Bowling -

Siave – 17 wickets @ 12.9.

Morton – 14 wickets @ 10.2.

Sorrell, Ned – 9 wickets @ 14.

Scotson – 7 wickets @ 21.8.

Special mention to Chris Siave who took on the role to often bowl at the death from the river end and bowl mainly the tough overs. Also worth mentioning Luke Strnadica taking on a new role to bowl first change with the harder ball to make the most of the bounce he gets. Often dismissing key players. Haydan once again was terrific in every game.

Batting -

Allenby - 307 run @ 51.1

Morton – 254 runs @ 50.8

Lawrie - 225 runs @ 45.0

Once again, many players played their roles effectively and sometimes out of position. Elliott and Haydan once again having great one day seasons. Special thanks to Elliott for staying in the middle order for us in order to lengthen the batting order and have some experience with me in the middle and late overs. The partnership between Elliott and Luke at Jandakot was pivotal in our season, having been 4 / 5 chasing 135. In the end knocking them off 4 down. A loss there would have made us 1 win and 2 losses and scrambling to make the top 2.

In terms of fielding, we couldn't claim to be the most mobile team, however what we lacked with youth and agility was made up with effort and skill. We used a new WK every game for the first 5 games,

quite the stat, settling on Jimmy Miguel as our number one WK. This proved to be a very successful move as he finished the season as a key part of the 2 day premiership with bat and gloves.

Overall we played 7 games in the regular season, winning 6 to secure a home GF against Hilton – Bicton. We played 2 games on Sundays, winning both despite not always having all of our players to choose from. Thank you John Brown and Sam Kelsey especially, for helping out in a 9 wicket win vs Piara. The energy in the field was electric!

The GF was a tough game for us, being outplayed by a very good Hilton Bicton team. We got our plans slightly off with a strong Easterly blowing at home and a very good innings played by Dane Ugle. The night that followed the loss was an enjoyable one despite the defeat, laying the foundation for a massive second half to the season.

Thank you to all players for buying in to the plans we had, Chade as coach was brilliant and thank you to Reggie for scoring and for the help. Thank you also to the committee for entrusting me as skipper for the season and the support all the way through. No doubt we will get better again next year.

#### THIRD GRADE REPORT

The past season begun with high expectations of what our third grade team could accomplish in the new season. With a combination of new and exciting young talent, and more experienced consistent players, I was truly very excited for the season to come, and what we could accomplish.

Unfortunately as the season progressed, players started to fall away, and like past seasons, we had to pillage players from the lower two grades. In total we had 52 players come through the team, and on many occasions, played with just 10. Sam Kelsey, Chade Steenholt and myself spent countless hours per week trying to call around and fill the side. Thank you to Sam and Chade for their help throughout the year.

Due to this instability, performance was not as amazing as first hoped, failing to reach finals in both the one-day and two-day competition. Coming off a one-day premiership in the past season, and two-day premiership in the 2021-22 season, not making finals was disappointing.

The season did start off in a positive and exciting manor, with a big win over the Leeming Spartans. Young gun Cam Sharp's 41 off of 62 balls set a nice platform for the third grade Bash Bros Tyler Sorrell (36 off 25 balls) and Jye McLaughlin (40 off 27 balls) to skyrocket our score to 8-253 off of our 40 overs. We went on to keep Leeming to just 8-158 off of their 40 overs, Cam Sharp taking 3 wickets, and Jye McLaughlin taking 2.

Taking confidence from our round 1 win led us to play good competitive cricket over the next few rounds, against strong opposition. Our next win came in round 4 against Pheonix, bowling them out for 137, and chasing it 6 down.

This led us to round 5, and the first two-day game of the year. This turned out to be our most convincing win of the season, and by far the highlight. Against Piara Waters we batted first. Myself and Danial Johannesen started well, with me being the first wicket (41 off 67 balls) at 1-72. Johannesen continued to bat superbly for a very well made 88. Cody Renouf (26 off 70 balls) and Taj Longmuir (20 off 34 balls) laid a solid foundation for the onslaught that was to come. Tyler Sorrell, in at 6 played the third grade innings of the year, with a blistering 90 not out, off just 44 balls, including 11 boundaries and 3 sixes. At the end of our 75 overs, we ended up on 8-323. The following week, we went on to bowl Piara Waters out for 181, winning by 142 runs.

This is where the year started to take a turn downhill, only winning 1 of the next 9 games to finish the season. We ended the season 4<sup>th</sup> overall in the one-day competition, and 5<sup>th</sup> overall in the two-day competition. Although not reaching finals, there were however some shining lights. The inclusion of new players Taj Longmuir (taking 14 wickets at 22), and Jaren Carr (9 wickets at 25), provided a breath of fresh air to the team, and I hope to see them stay with the club and improve over the coming years.

With the results at the back end of the year going the way they did, moral and enjoyment also went down. The boys who finished off the season in third grade are glad that it is over, and looking forward to more greater successful years for the team in the future. I would personally like to thank everyone that put their hand up to commit to 2 day cricket, and help get a team on the park.

Some stand out performances from the season include;

- Jye McLaughlin with another best and fairest season. 11 wickets at 25 bowling from the river end, and 220 runs at 31.43. Jye played countless crucial innings, and took multiple important wickets throughout the season. Jye also captained the team on many occasions when I was playing first grade.
- Ryan Jones's consistency with the ball, leading our bowling attack with 17 wickets at 22.24. This hard work won Ryan the third grade bowling award. Ryan also captained the team in multiple games. His experience as captain in the past and knowledge of the game is priceless.
- Danial Johannesen's great year with the bat, taking out our batting award. 263 runs at an average of 32.88 is an amazing accomplishment opening the batting. Unfortunately Danial works fifo, so was not available as much as we would have liked, but when he did play, he dominated.
- Charlie Mustard, leading the batting average for the season, with 217 runs at 43.4. Charlie is a true young talent that we hope to steal away from district cricket, to continue dominating the SMCA.
