Not to single out any one team but the One Day B lads (most straight out of winning a U/17's premiership) brought a fresh lease of life to the club with their enthusiasm and willingness to win against the odds. Well lead by Ryan Jones, the whole club looks forward to all the boys returning and playing at a higher grade next season.

Thanks to all the captains for your efforts during the season, Special mention to Greg Beresi for taking over the reins as coach, Nick taking over the 1st grade captaincy, Val Steenholdt as nets Captain and to their support coaches Jonah, Chade and Clanga.

Our annual windup was held at the clubrooms for the first time in over a decade. With the newly renovated clubhouse the committee went with a cocktail style event with finger food served and cash bar, which was staffed by our good friends from the lacrosse club. Congratulations must also go to our Best & Fairest recipient, Chris Siave. Congrats mate you had a great season filled with many match winning performances. Keep knocking on that door mate!

The 2nd XI season was once again a bit of a mixed bag with the gap between our best and our worst not quite where we'd like things. Having said that we managed to once again win our way through to competing for the one-day final of which we weren't as successful as last year.

This season we continued to build on the team ethos of “no bullshit” and enjoying our time on the park together. Plenty of laughs were shared and this culminated in a cracking end of season trip to Gracetown in May... Patty Vallence's singing talents are now legendary down there.

Our season started with a bang, welcoming Willetton to the 3rd grade competition. The game saw the debuts of the elusive Rheinberger Brothers... who may have taken their hydration a bit too earnestly the night before. Hydration aside, Kane Rheinberger pushed through on a hot, muggy day claiming his first EFCC pole... followed up by revisiting his breakfast at fine leg. We got ourselves to the Xmas break sitting 6 wins from 8 games and were quietly confident about what lay ahead for us. This confidence showing in our first game after the break, taking care of Phoenix comfortably with Mouse taking 4 wickets and Chris Siave bagging 5-for.

We accounted for Leeming the following week, booking ourselves a spot in the one-day final for the 4th consecutive year. The final didn't go to the same plan as the year prior, letting Cockburn get away from us after I lost another toss. Chasing 157 to win a one-day final at Davilak was always going to be a tough task, and ultimately it was a bridge too far... bowled out for 116. A couple of highlights post Xmas:

- Hugh Norcross captaining the side in week 1 vs CBC and lead with the bat making 59 – his second highest score for the club.
- A 4th wicket, 183 run stand vs Willetton between Rhys Jones (114*) & Brendon Clancy (95).
- An outright win against Leeming with Cam Youngson & Nory talking 6 wickets each for the match.

This all lead to second place on the ladder and a home semi-final vs Kardinya. Ultimately we did what we could but fell short of the mark. Once again I couldn't win a toss and we were asked to bowl first. Some early wayward bowling gave them the momentum of which it took us some time to claw back. However, in true EFCC spirit we managed to restrict them to a total of 232 when much, much more

was looking likely.

The next day with the bats we started brightly and continued to tick the score along. But the good old East Fremantle shuffle reared its head on a couple of occasions hurting our chances of bringing home the win. In the end we were bowled out for 191.

It wasn't the best way to finish a strong season but it was nonetheless enjoyable. There was a load of laughs, banter & a few tins after most games... Change room frofs are still the best tasting beers in the world! Once again it was a pleasure to share the field with all of the 30 different players that helped the 2nd XI this year.

I owe a debt of gratitude to plenty of people at the club for their assistance throughout the season and I thank anyone that has helped in one way or another with us in the 2's this year.

Many thanks to the committee for yet another great season of cricket. To try and get eleven blokes out there on a Saturday is sometimes a battle and with your assistance it makes it easier to focus on the tasks at hand.

To our outgoing President Vic Strnadica, it has been a pleasure to work alongside you and help continue to drive this great club forward. Your unwavering efforts for East Freo are very much noticed and appreciated from us all. I look forward to beer or 5 next season with you..!

A special mention must go to Vice Captain Blake Lawrie. As most people know Mouse is a cracking person to play cricket with and the laughs are there both on & off the field. However, he does a power of work behind the scenes at the club both at a committee level and match day as well. One Day B Grade

The 2015/16 One Day B's team (AKA The Future) was a group full of fresh faced, young and eager cricketers, aged 16-18, seeking to prove themselves in their first year of senior cricket (or living up to their name as already established EFCC cricket stars). Although not reaching the ultimate success, the team was able to finish in third place on the ladder, in a league that people claimed was the highest standard of cricket seen in years for a One Day grade. Although having the opportunity to compete in a semi-final against Cannington Tigers, we were unsuccessful in winning the chance to play in the Grand Final, playing one of our poorer performances of the season.

The team was formed early, in the pre-season stage, with a group of 7 junior cricketers from Bicton Junior Cricket Club (Premiers from the previous season) looking to continue playing together at senior level. Throughout the season, more young pups joined our growing squad, and soon our team consisted of 10 players under the age of 20. Going into the season the team goal was to merely play our best cricket and test ourselves against some quality senior cricketers, getting a sense of senior cricket and bridging the gap from junior level to senior level. To help guide our young team as "mentor" figures were Tony Miguel, Paull Rowe and Brad Valiukas, as well as the parents (shout out to the Dads who filled in when needed) and the club as a whole, all who were very welcoming, supportive and great instructors in a variety of things (cricket and non-cricketing).

After a shaky start to the season against Cannington, I was having concerns about whether the team was ready and committed to playing the season in full seriousness. Thankfully I was proven wrong in the following round fixture against Kelmscott, choosing to bowl first and having our front-line bowler Ned Sorrell available for selection, we ran through the entire batting line up in just 17 overs, Ned taking a maiden 5 wicket haul, 6/9 off 6 overs, as well as taking 2 catches and snagging a run-out.

This set the tone for the next 4 weeks, taking us to 5 wins and 1 loss, and looking as an ominous, young side. At times favouring our ability with the ball, and other times with the bat, highly reflective of our team's diversity and all round talent.

To end out the first half of the season, the team had the opportunity to face Cannington again, a game I saw as a measuring device to see how far the team had evolved over the first 10 weeks. Needless to say a slow but solid 41 to Luke Foley gave us a defendable 170. Again the star of the show however was Ned, taking his second 5fa, with figures of 5/17 including a maiden hat-trick, winning us the game, rolling Cannington for 46 in 12.1 overs, and leaving the team 6 and 4 on the win/loss scale.

A shaky start to the second half of the season put us at some risk of not making the finals, however two tight, impressive wins against Riverton-Rostrata (by 2 runs) and Kardinya (by 4 wickets) granted us a finals berth.

As I've previously mentioned our failure in the semi, I'll just outline the key individual highlights of the season.

- EFCC debuts to Joshua Monaghan, Joshua Ogden, Matthew Sorrell, Samuel Ainge (dropout), Luke Foley, James Miguel, Tyler Sorrell, Ned Sorrell, Nathan Bodlovich and myself (Ryan Jones).
- Ned Sorrell 6/9, Rnd 2 vs Kelmscott
- Matt Sorrell 4/43 and 65 runs against Leeming, Rnd 4 vs Leeming
- Paull Rowe 68 runs and Tony Miguel 63 runs, Rnd 5 vs Willetton
- Paull Rowe 80 runs, Rnd 6 vs Armadale
- Josh Ogden 6/22 off 6.2 overs, Rnd 9 vs Cockburn

- Ned Sorrell 5/17 and hat-trick, Rnd 10 vs Cannington Tigers
- Luke Foley 50 runs, Rnd 14 vs Willetton
- Ryan Jones 67 runs and Joshua Monaghan 58 runs, Rnd 15 vs Riverton-Rostrata

The above is a testament to the potential contained within our squad, with such a wide variety of players and achievements throughout the season, essentially a team of all-rounders. Not to forget the players who are not mentioned in the above highlights, as each player contributed with either multiple 30-40 run knocks, amazing fielding flare or 3-4 wicket hauls.

I must also quickly recognise the winners of particular awards within the team, Paull Rowe taking out the batting with 326 runs at 25.08, opening the batting each week Rowie could often be hit or miss, but when he was on, you'd know it, his 80 run knock will be an unforgettable innings, 6's and 4's everywhere. The bowling aggregate went to James Miguel taking 28 wickets at 19.04, being the youngest in the team and a leg spinner, James often appeared to the opposition as an easy target to smack around, yet his temperament, patience and deception often had the opposition in disarray. The bowling average was however taken by pace ace Ned Sorrell, 24 wickets at 13.71, often intimidating the opening batsmen with his heat and out swing, often going for no more than 2 runs per over in his first spell and would be deadly with his Yorkers and consistent line and length in his second spell, stopping any batsmen, regardless of their form. Fielding went to the skipper, 19 catches and 3 unassisted run outs, most likely winning due to being able to field wherever I want.

I cannot speak highly enough of how well our team gelled and worked together, always supporting, encouraging and learning from one another. I sit here confident in knowing that in years to come, the East Fremantle Cricket Club will contain not just two or three, but seven or eight First Grade players. Through the continuous ongoing support and learning opportunities the club has granted us, we will develop very quickly into smart, mature and highly skilled cricketers. I know I speak on behalf of the group when I say we are eager to help develop and guide the next bunch of young cricketers to help them just as the community has for us.

I can't express how eager I am to get cracking on next season, developing my cricket and hopefully winning a premiership this time around! Although our plans for next year haven't been confirmed, I can assure you that this group of young cricketers will be back next season, ready to make our mark in the club and competition.
