President's Report

I could fill pages talking about the efforts of each of these guys, all who worked outside their personal job descriptions to step up for your club. Thanks guys you all contributed to the large task of voluntarily running the club to ensure this year was an enjoyable one...well most of the time!

Many thanks to all those people who in some way kindly volunteered their time this year to assist with the administration of the club, and also to all our valued sponsors for their generosity.

I would like to thank all of those members who voted for me at the 2008 AGM. It has been a challenging year but I can honestly say that I am proud to have had the opportunity to be President of our great Club and look forward to the challenges that lie ahead in 2009/10. I would also like to thank Blake Lawrie for assisting Gary and Scott with Bar Duties and also a big thank you to Anne Fairhead who kindly volunteered to supply and prepare afternoon teas at Preston Point each week as well as doing some scoring. Thanks Anne. The afternoon teas were always delicious and appreciated by the guys. Also thanks to Jon Middleton who took on the role of Coordinator of the Life Members group. It was great to see some of our long time Life Members attend functions during the year including Don Lang, Jim Hurst, Les Capes and Peter Stephen. It's always a pleasure to have you guys at the club and you know you are always welcome.

I'd like to add a big thank you to Mark Bogensperger who took on the thankless role of Chairman of Selectors. Mark is the first Chairman of selectors in the club's history to fully embrace technology and each Thursday he would arrive at the club with his lap top and log onto "My Cricket" and select the teams, as well as making literally hundreds of phone calls throughout the year. The position requires a strong character and Bogie only had to call me in 3 or 4 times during the season when there was a stalemate on selection issues. Well done Bogie and I hope to see you back in the same role next year.

We had some 101 players represent the club this year and 44 of these played 4 games or less. This is a disturbing trend brought about in some cases by fly in fly out employment and shift work. It was unfortunate that we had to

forfeit several games in One Day B's this year. Although employment is a factor I also think there is sometimes a lack of commitment in some cases.

Some of you may have watched the AFL documentary on the box a couple of weeks ago. It was called "Essence of the Game". Towards the end of the program former Carlton coach David Parkin was reminiscing about a famous quote from the legendary Hawks coach Jon Kennedy, which he said to Parkin in his days as a young Hawks player. He said: "Fill the pages of your glorious youth, for they will quickly turn" I implore all you young guys to take this on. Don't waste your youth, don't get involved with club politics and don't just be satisfied with being an average player and look back when your book has nearly closed and say "If only I had of trained a bit harder , If only I hade greater commitment, If only I..."

Start to fill your pages now with good memories. My book of youth has closed but I can tell you some of my best life experiences have come through my involvement with cricket. Playing in 14 senior premierships and meeting many fine people along the way has given me many fond memories.

So next season it won't be me or the committee who will be solely responsible to get our club back to where it belongs. It will be up to each and every one of us. We need to take a more professional approach with our cricket. Sure we are an amateur club, but most of us play competitive team sport because we enjoy the winning feeling that only a team sport can bring. We will only have a strong club when we have competition for positions throughout our grades and guys wanting to push up the grades, guys wanting to play week in week out. Guys committing to the team, guys committing to the club and guys committing to one another to achieve the ultimate team success.

When you look at the SMCA clubs there are the Spartans, Phoenix, Armadale, Kelmscott etc etc. But everyone in this room is here tonight and some who have been here for 5 or more decades and they are here because they are loyal to a club who holds one of the greatest if not the greatest names in Australian Sport, so its fitting that we once again hold a wind up in the social hall of one of the most successful sporting clubs in Australia. EAST FREMANTLE. Remember that name both in Football and Cricket, and as we move towards the future remember to do your bit to ensure that our great club will still be here when we have all gone.

Although our 1st Grade played finals cricket which was a sound achievement, I do believe they would have been stronger if we had of had pressure from our 2nd and 4th Grade teams. Sadly the depth of batting talent was shallow this year as the departure of 6-7 quality 1st Graders forced a few of our veterans to play up the grades. Thanks to all those vets who pushed up for the club and never once complained about it. Normally in a cricketer's twilight years you tend to slowly drift down the grades and this year saw 4 players over the age of 40 play 1st Grade, as well as another few playing 2nds all season.

A total of 28 players represented 1st Grade in 2008/09 and from being 1st Grade Grand Finalists in 2007/08 it was always going to be either a case of sustained success or post premier blues. When we played Leeming in the first Round we had a staggering eight new faces from our 07/08 1st Grade Grand

Final Team. A large turnover for various reasons, however this turnover did present opportunities to some of our up and coming players who in previous seasons had limited 1st Grade opportunities. We won that first game against the odds and some of these guys quickly proved that they could match it in the 1st Grade arena. Hugh Norcross, Scott Knight, Andrew Stephen , Brett Sprigg, Joel Mouritz, Cam Youngson, Tim Jury and newcomer to the club Carl Jackson. The addition of Greg Beresi in Round 2 was unfortunately offset by the loss of Chris Siave for the season. We welcomed one new established 1st Grade player to the club in Nick Siave and Nick had an excellent year where he displayed his all-round skill set consistently throughout the season.

Thanks to Chris Siave for voluntarily taking on the coaching role after our initial appointment did not come to fruition and also to Greg Beresi for taking on the captaincy mid season. Both of these guys did a great job and were instrumental in steering the 1st Grade Team to the finals.

A total of 41 players represented 2nd grade this season, and this statistic alone showed it was difficult to get some continuity which is a hallmark of successful sides at this level. The team was led by club stalwart Daren "Dog" Muir. It was a disappointing season however it gave some players exposure at this level and that can only assist in their career development. Thanks for your efforts "Dog", and although it's sad to see a great player such as you retire, we hope that you will be around the club in some capacity next season.

Our 4th Grade was led by Adam "Frenchy" Jorre De St Jorre this season, and you gotta take your hat off to this guy who travelled from Bullsbrook to Preston Point each Tuesday and Thursday and very rarely did he miss a training session. Well done Frenchie on your efforts. Always entertaining and a great bloke to have around the club. Not a memorable season for the 4th Grade but as the saying goes "There's always next year"

Our One Day B's had several leaders throughout the season and thanks to Paul Faranda, John Olczyk, Kelvin Gray and Brodie Renouf for taking on the captaincy duties. The team won 6 of their matches and had it not been for several forfeits then finals may have been a real possibility.

The two SMCA 1st Grade grand finalists from 2007/08 were invited to participate in the WACA State-wide 20/20 knockout competition. Much to the clubs and players delight we drew Esperance in Esperance and on 16th November 2008, a touring party of 15 from our club flew out headed for Esperance. It was an excellent trip and although we did not win the game it was certainly a great experience which greatly assisted in building some camaraderie for the season ahead.

The inaugural East Fremantle Melbourne Cup was held this year. An enjoyable night with the phantom call of the East Fremantle Cup, which for memory was won by the "2 Monkeys". The only thing that disappointed the crowd was the mouse races as promised by Mooshy didn't come to fruition. Nice work Gary on organising the night and a sound marketing strategy in pre-advertisement of the mouse races. This just could turn into a bigger and better social event next year, and maybe the mice just might put in an appearance next time.

This year the committee, in conjunction with the Phoenix Cricket Club, were most pleased to establish a Perpetual Memorial Match. The Inaugural Trevor Sprigg – Frank Rourke Memorial 1st Grade Match Vs Phoenix took place on 13th and 20th Dec 2008. This 1st Grade fixture will now be an annual event with after match fellowship to be hosted by the home club. The match has been established to forever honour the memory our late esteemed life member Trevor Sprigg and also the late Frank Rourke who played for both the East Fremantle and Phoenix Clubs. Although we lost the inaugural match the after match fellowship with past and present Phoenix and East Fremantle players was second to none. A memorable day and one that we will now look forward to each season. From the proceeds of the day we donated \$200 to the Murdoch Hospice and the SMCA also donated \$100 to the same cause.

Well that's enough on the season that was. Going forward I want to see "RESPECT" return to our club, the same sort of respect that was at the club when I commenced back in 1985, but since my return in 1998 I have slowly see it diminish. It disappoints and hurts me when through different sources this year I have been told that our club has got a poor reputation. 1st Grade Captain's Report

I believe the 2008/2009 season was a great learning curve for both the A-grade squad and club. From last year's all conquering premiership team there was only a handful of original players still at the club. With such a turnover of players early speculation and criticism came from other clubs who wrote us off as any threat to the competition. Although we had lost some big name players we were able to recruit well and younger players within the club were able to get their chance.

After round 4 clubs were starting to realize the full potential of this supposed broken team. This dream start was accomplished by solid batting performances, smart bowling spells, some dynamic captaincy from Hudson Trevenen and a great endeavor to prove the A-grade competition wrong.

By the Christmas break 6 rounds had been completed and we had won 4 and lost 2, with both our defeats being tight tussles against tough opposition with sessions in the games where we were in winning positions. Despite the defeats this was a great start and set us up well for the second part of the season.

After the break our first game saw us defeated by CBC, our third consecutive loss and the criticism heard earlier in the season was brewing yet again. It was at this time I was appointed captain and our former skipper declared his retirement from the game. I'd like to personally thank Hudson Trevenen for the last 2 seasons. He did offer some good thoughts as a player and a captain.

If we wanted to go anywhere in the competition this season it was now time to reflect, regroup, move on and get back to winning games of cricket. Of the remaining 4 games we were able to defeat Riverton-Rostrata, Armadale and Kelmscott whilst narrowly going down to Cockburn. This solid finish was achieved with team unity, belief and also the appointment of our new coach Chris Siave.

We ended the season finishing 5th and travelled to Tempest Park to take on Phoenix. Past encounters have resulted in epic struggles for cricketing supremacy between both respected clubs. I believe to defeat Phoenix at their home ground is the hardest game you can win in the SMCA competition.

At the end of play on the first day we bowled Phoenix for 183. A great bowling performance considering they were 2/130 with two well-set batsman looking dangerous. The general feeling amongst the group was very positive and confident that we could chase the runs. Our batting innings started and finished poorly with no batsman getting on top and we consistently lost wickets. We ended up being bowled out for 82 and comprehensively beaten.

There is still a sense of what could have been for our season with the earlier injury to Chris Siave and the unavailability of Aaron Andrich and Brent Fairhead for the final. With cricket being the strange game it is the grand final

was played out by Leeming and Armadale, teams that we had beaten during the season and bowled each of them out for less than 95 runs.

Congratulations must be given to Nick Siave who had a great season and won the A Grade fairest and best. I believe Nick is one of the best all-rounders in the competition and it's been a pleasure playing alongside you. This year has also seen the return of Hugh Norcross, a very gifted and talented bowler who terrorized batting attacks and ended the season as leading wicket taker. I must give special mention to players like Scott Knight, Joel Mouritz, Brett Sprigg and Carl Jackson who have all shown they have great potential and a long future at the club.

I'd like to thank Mark Holt and the committee for having the confidence in my ability to lead the team. Thanks also to the A Grade squad for your support and understanding, I'm sure we'll all be here next season doing it all again.
