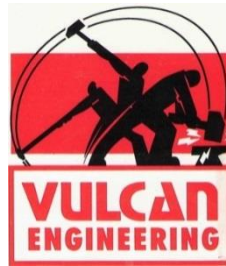

Team Reports & Statistics

First Grade Report & Statistics

For the first grade side, the story of this season started last winter. After having won a premiership and securing an important piece of history for our club, we were informed that the man that led us there was not going to be able to captain again due to work commitments. With no obvious replacements, the club's cricket sub-committee was burdened with a very tough decision, and in the end I was chosen to lead the club into the 2012-13 season.

We started extremely well, winning our first three matches despite losing a lot of time to rain and having a tough time putting runs on the board. This trend was reversed when a Benny Mustard special saw us chase down a total of 195 in just 28 overs in round three. Benny was at his brutal best in smashing 105 runs, only needing to run for 21 of those.

Our one day form was not quite as impressive, with our seven home and away games yielding four wins, two losses and a tie. Our knack for pulling victory from the jaws of defeat was seen again as Hilton rolled us for 123, only to have us come back to have them all out for 94 as Nick Siave bagged a season best 6/17. We made the One Day Grand Final for the first time in the club's history, facing Leeming away from home. Unfortunately, we didn't have the right answers when the opposition opening batsmen put on a stand of 122 in just 23 overs, effectively killing the game off.

We continued with the remaining two day games of the year, and were undefeated at home during the regular season. It was during this period that Brad Kelly made a return to the club, and it didn't take long for him to slot back into our line up. We won back the Sprigg-Rourke shield in a well-supported fixture which has been cemented as a significant occasion for both the East Fremantle and Phoenix cricket clubs.

Finishing the regular season on top of the ladder, we had a home semi-final against Leeming. Another solid performance from our bowling unit saw us dismiss them for 135 on day one. The second day saw an extraordinarily gutsy effort from Brad Kelly and Blake "Mr February" Miller blunt the Leeming attack and open the door for the middle order to finish the job and put us into the Grand Final.

This was devastatingly going to be the second Grand Final that we were to lose in just two months. We worked hard to the end and didn't go down without a fight, but it wasn't enough.

As a new captain calling the shots in a well-established team that had already seen ultimate success the previous year, it was never going to be all smooth sailing. We have the most depth of talent of any club in the competition, and this is something that is brilliant to have on your side as a captain and selector. There was always a ready replacement from the other grades when one was required. However, taking over a premiership side brings with it a weight of expectation and a difficulty establishing and maintaining authority for which I was clearly unprepared.

It was a year of highs and lows, culminating in a bitter end which saw us lose that which perhaps we thought we had already won. If this very dark cloud has a silver lining, it's that our pride and self-respect will not allow for this to be the end for us a player group. Despite there being no more fixtures for us to play in the 2012-13 season, this is a story that is far from over.

Third Grade Report & Statistics

For the second season in a row... second is not success; But by making the grand final, the team can be proud that it represented the East Fremantle Cricket Club in the manner it would want – strong competitive spirit, good sportsmanship and the best afternoon teas in the competition.

Preseason. A strong representation at preseason training, and the emergence of the home grown talent indicated a strong pool for all two day grades, and the third grade challenge, it appeared at the time, was to maintain a core team when all players in the third grade could push for first grade selection, and or host first grade cricketers attempting to regain their spot, and this was to prove correct. Over the season, we lost through the strength of the club players of the calibre of Christopher Speed, Jamie Bunn and Graedon Irvine through non-selection, and many players who would normally have played the odd game, were not required.

R1 – 4. The season started with all four possible results – a draw, a loss, a tie, and a win. We won't see that very often, but definitely more often than a Royal Flush at the EFCC Poker Tournament, which also occurred early in the season.

One Day Series. The one day series of seven one day games against each club was successful, as the team went undefeated in the series. It commenced with the double header weekend which yielded wins against Leeming and CBC. EFCC avenged its tie to Armadale in R3 with a good win in R6 with Ben Tasker carrying his bat for 98* with Rhys Jones nonchalantly accumulating 65 in what seemed like no time at all. Campbell Youngson had five wickets and Armadale were 7/32 after 16 overs, before we switched off and let Armadale end their innings at 8/180 from 40 overs. Rod Sammut (135) and Stuart Youngson (93) amassed a 223 run fourth wicket partnership against Kardinya to guide EFCC to a score of 7/313 (40) and a good win.

Rod Sammut (61) and Nick Bonner's (111*) partnership of 144 contributed the bulk of the runs in EFCC's score of 4/211 against Phoenix, with the bowling and fielding restricting Phoenix to 7/146 in reply. Danial Johannesen again finished off the EFCC innings Michael Bevan-like, to get us home against Hilton Palmyra after Campbell Youngson had earlier produced the tidy figures of 4/6 from eight overs. In the final game of the series, EFCC chased down 234 Cockburn runs to win with Ben Tasker (58) and Nick Bonner (59) teaming for a partnership of 121 in the chase.

The one day grand final against Hilton Palmyra was a typical EFCC and HPCC performance, Hilton won the toss, elected to bat, EFCC restricted them to 8/153 from 40 overs and EFCC chased the runs down, again finished off by Danial Johannesen. It was great to win a premiership for EFCC, and the team celebrated well that night.

Two Day Series. The first three games were winless and saw EFCC seventh on the ladder. Coincidentally, these three opponents would all end up in the final four with EFCC so we were to go into the two day finals without a victory against any other team in the two day format. During this period, the only significant contributions with the bat were from Graedon Irvine with 50 against Hilton Palmyra and John Brown with 51 against Armadale. Danial Johannesen produced a Michael Bevan-like innings at the end of the Armadale game to get EFCC to the point of requiring one run from the last two balls of the innings. Unfortunately for Jamie Bunn, he was unable to connect to either balls, and the game ended in a anticlimactic tie. The bowling group, led by Campbell Youngson kept opposition teams to around 200, with Blake Lawrie, Campbell Youngson and Danial Johannesen taking the bulk of the wickets, with good support from Mick Leatherday and Jamie Bunn at the other ends. By the fourth two day game, despite the ladder showing EFCC on top at this point in time, we were yet to actually win a two day game, but had won seven consecutive one day games so felt ready for its relatively light run home against Kardinya, Leeming, CBC and Phoenix, all of which were bottom four by this stage. By now, the batting group were firing with defendable scores of 278, 292, 417 and 198, with runs flowing from Rhys Jones, Rod Sammut, Stuart Youngson, Ben Tasker, Danial Johannesen and Patrick Vallence. The bowling group were taking ten wickets each time they took the field, executing teams for 155, 74, 260 and 116, with wickets from Chris Siave, Josh Robin, John Brown, and the EFCC 2nd XI veterans Campbell Youngson and Blake Lawrie. EFCC won all four games to take the team to twelve wins straight into the semi final.

Semi Final. Borrowing from EFCC great John Olczyk, and the slow Henry Jeffrey oval, I elected to bowl first to apply fielding pressure to Hilton Palmyra. The bowling group did very well and Hilton were restricted to 4/63 after 40 overs at tea. The pressure eventually cracked Hilton open, and Hugh Norcross took five wickets after tea to finish with 6/15. All bowlers contributed in restricting Hilton Palmyra to an indefensible total of 76. The EFCC batting group reached 77 by 5:20pm and Hilton Palmyra conceded. It was the perfect execution of our game plan, and yielded the outcome we wanted.

Grand Final. Again, winning the toss and electing to field, and again the bowling group performed very well to restrict Cockburn to 9/130 by 4:59pm, the Cockburn captain made a competitive declaration to force EFCC to bat for twenty minutes at the end of the first day. The EFCC openers accounted for Cockburn, and at stumps were 0/20 from eight overs. Day two drew a large number of supporters for both teams. It was evident early that Cockburn were unified and nothing separated them or their goal for the day, whereas EFCC were inter-mingled sparsely amongst supporters and conversations not related to the game at hand. Rhys Jones was run out by his opening partner, I was bowled by a good ball, and thereafter no EFCC batsman controlled the crease, nor looked to turn the strike over, something the team had focussed on all year - singles. On the last day of the season, our own strategy, to restrict singles, was used against us, and just as we had done to opposition teams all season, we crumbled under the pressure that it created. EFCC were bowled out for 104 and lost the grand final.

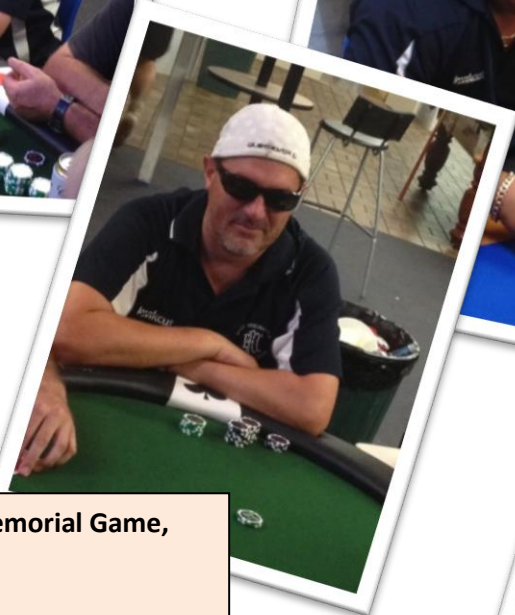
