### Coach's Report

The committee met after last season and decided the club needed a change in the coaching department. Reg was appointed Coach with Chopper the Chairman of Selectors. Unfortunately, Reg couldn't commit to the job and I soon found myself taking training in the pre-season. Numbers were down on last year and we decided to field only 4 teams, which was definitely the correct decision!

I was then asked by the committee to take on the job; and without any experience in this role, I dived in head first! We struggled for numbers at training in the pre-season, which doesn't surprise too many. Once the season got under way there were some reasonable numbers on the track and we were able to get into quality fielding drills. As I mention in my captain's report, Whitey and Kiwi were a great help prior to Xmas with these fielding drills and passed on their experience.

However, the quality of training and the attendance slipped considerably after Xmas. A number of players had work commitments and couldn't train at all. Others missed training spasmodically and this made it hard to separate the top-side squad. Unfortunately, we were unable to penalise players for not training due to our lack of depth. This led to the mentality that missing training was acceptable and our on-field performances reflected this.

Chopper was a huge help this year (as he is every year!) organising the nets on a Thursday and all the equipment. He & I struggled through every selection night making numerous phone calls to check the availability of players and piecing the sides together. It is not an easy job and the players probably got sick of hearing my voice down the club this year. I believe we need to separate the role of coach and top-side captain. This would enhance any messages that are being put across and get more out of the players.

While it was tough and challenging, it was still an enjoyable year with some good signs for the future. The emergence and improvement of some of our younger cricketers was great to see. For these guys like Eddy, Josh, Hugh, Olaf, Mossy, Myles and Beaker to get experience in the top side is a good experience. We need to retain these players and develop more juniors to replace the ageing stalwarts that had to grace the 2A field this

year. It was also a magnificent effort for the 3Bs to win the one-day final and make the 2-day final. Well done to PC and the boys – you have made it a successful year!!

I learnt a lot about coaching the game this year and will be better for the experience. I would like to thank each and every player for the year and wish you the best in your cricket. I will not be coaching again next year but will be endeavouring to find a replacement that has the time and experience to take this club to where it should be.

### 2A's Captain's Report

The 2003/04 year can only be described as one of the toughest the club has encountered in the time I have been involved. It was disappointing to finish last in 1<sup>st</sup> Grade last year and be relegated to 2A's again after all our hard work getting into 1<sup>st</sup> Grade. We then lost some of the key players from last year in Steve Beatty, Cam Duffy and Grant Woodhead. While this was a setback, we still had an array of talent and were confident that we could be more than competitive in the 2A competition. We had recruited 2 players that had played 1<sup>st</sup> Grade for Armadale; however one didn't play a game and the other only a handful. We were behind the 8-ball from the start, but I believed if we could get through the early rounds with a couple of wins, we could be successful.

Our batting struggled early in the season with the top order sadly out of nick as we lost early wickets and failed to build partnerships. A combination of poor shot selection and losses in concentration resulted in the middle and lower order having to salvage bad starts. At the halfway mark, we were 3 wins from 7 games and still in with a chance if we could improve and win the close games.

Then the Xmas break gave us a couple of weeks to think about our season and also resulted in us losing 2 of our most experienced players in Whitey and Kiwi. It was disappointing to lose these blokes who had contributed not only on the field but also at training with their fielding drills. It was at this point that I decided to blood a few younger guys (and a few seasoned veterans) to see if we could turn the season around. We lost our next 3 games to SJ Blues, Roleystone and Kardinya which hurt our finals aspirations.

We then won against Cockburn and Maddington to reignite our chances and at this time we had the strong belief and team spirit that had been missing. With Josh and Eddy opening the bowling and Benny Mustard back in the side, we looked and performed a lot better. Unfortunately, the loss to Leeming by 7 runs when we failed to defend 261 hurt us badly. We dropped one guy 5 times and he went on the make a ton. This was hard to take and we finished the season a disappointing 5<sup>th</sup>.

This result is nowhere near good enough considering the players we had available during the year. Sure, certain things didn't go our way at times, but no excuses can be made. I for one didn't perform with the bat and learnt from a few mistakes with my captaincy. Other players weren't consistent enough with the bat and we dropped chances at crucial times in matches we should have won. We also lost key performers halfway through the year that destabilised the side.

We can however take a number of positives out of the season, which holds us in good stead for next year:

- Josh Rivers showed massive improvement to be elevated from the lower grades and ended up joint leading wicket-taker for our side with 19. Josh, with a bit more coaching & guidance, you'll become a strike bowler for the club in years to come.
- As will his opening bowling partner, Elliott Lawrie. Eddy was in NZ for the start of the season and came into the side just prior to Xmas and ended up

taking the new ball for the top side. He is a raw 18 year old and was too good for a number of top order players in this comp. Look forward to seeing you bowl well for the club next year Ed.

- Treve came back from the UK and made 2 great 100's for the side this year and while he has expressed disappointment with his season, he made a huge difference when joining the side in round 4. Hope to put a few big partnerships on with you next year Brown.
- Mr C.D.Q. Cole tried his guts out for me this year, making 281 runs and taking 19 wickets. He trains hard and has enormous talent. If Mr C.D.Q. Cole can maintain his concentration and improve his consistency, he will hurt a lot of teams with bat and ball.
- Butters joined us from Melbourne and was a great addition to the side and the club. His safe hands, generous nature at the cards table and strong lower order hitting were appreciated by all. Hope to see you back next year Butts.
- Benny Mustard came back from a knee recon to add some strength to the top order. Thanks Benny, it will be great to get a full season out of you next year.
- Matty & Kiwi your assistance in the 1<sup>st</sup> half of the year on the field and at training was much appreciated. You are valuable members of our club and we want you guys back next year to pass on your experience and help win that elusive premiership.
- Olly is going on 40 and when I asked him to step up and play in the top side to add some experience, he made himself available. Not only that, he tried his guts out and produced some brilliant spells of bowling as well as solid lower order batting. Thanks Ol.
- Reg and Holty, thanks for your help this year, adding experience to our side and helping out our young blokes.

You blokes are all much improved players and better for the experience – we need you next year pushing for a spot in the top side again!
