It has come to the end of yet another entertaining and exciting season of Under 17's cricket. I was extremely proud of the way the players went about their cricket and for such an inexperienced group of players, they showed great promise for the years to come.

With East Fremantle being on the verge of failing to fill an Under 17's side this year, it didn't look like we were going to be playing at all, but thanks to the help and commitment of some keen Kardinya players and parents we were able to gather enough to get started.

I thought having such a mixed bunch of kids who didn't even know each other from a bar of soap would be quite a challenge to get them to gel together and play competitive cricket, but after the first game I could see that we would get along fine as the enjoyment was evident in all their faces even after a loss.

I felt we underachieved slightly at times due to the fact that there were games that could have easily gone our way had we taken our opportunities and really stayed focused 100%. On the other hand I was thrilled with their efforts considering they are a young group of boys who have the whole of next season to really show their true ability and display the same confidence that I saw in the last two performances.

This is how I believe junior cricket should be run, to give everyone a go as much as possible.

A huge thanks must go out to the team manager, Kim King, for her tireless efforts throughout the season, without her this East Fremantle team simply would not have existed. Not only did you organise everything behind the scenes but you showed great support to both me and the players and for that we are very grateful. Thanks to all the parents as well, you guys have been fantastic with your willingness each week either by helping with the scoring or getting the boys warmed up - it is all greatly appreciated. I look forward to working with all of you closely in future years down at the club.

I am eagerly looking forward to coaching these boys next season, as I understand how crucial the influx of 17's players is for our seniors. When I return from the UK I will be ready to mount a stronger challenge next year hopefully with the same bunch of guys who will have had that learning year out of the way and be ready to pose a threat on the premiership.

So how did the season pan out... Well, we actually started quite slowly this season, I guess finding our feet in the higher grade. Unfortunately we lost four of our first five fixtures, the first game by only 7 runs, which was to prove costly in the final wash-up. With a run of one-day games we then won four of our next five to put us back on even terms (5 wins -5 losses). In our first game after the Christmas break we needed to win to make the One-day final, unfortunately due to a number of key players missing we went down to a very strong Phoenix side. Our season never really recovered after this, winning just two of our last four matches to miss out on the finals by a matter of just 1.1 points.

It must be remembered that due to redeveloping a club into a true power club we must blood youngsters, and this was again apparent this year. For the majority of the season either **'Bully'** or myself were the elder statesmen of the team at just 29, and the majority of guys where between 17 and 23. Now that augurs well for the future!

Looking ahead the key area I believe the 2nd grade side (and the club) needs to look at prior to next season is the top to middle order batsmen available. We were quite brittle towards the end of the season, with it ultimately costing us dearly in the final game, and a two-day finals spot. This is backed by only 5 batsmen averaging more than 20 for the grade, and only 2 of these played more than 4 games. A batsman (or two) to bolster the top order is a must for next season. This will give us the flexibility to bat people were they can serve the club best and put pressure on the 1st grade bats for positions.

The Lads:

Cam 'Brown Dog' Brown is the supreme clubman off and on the field. Cam was a solid top order bat for us this year putting together a knock of 49 and a number of starts in the 20's. Cam was most noted for his partnerships, especially one of 112 with Craig Cole, of which Cam scored 18. Like all top order bats Cam was at me all year for a bowl, when given the nod he had admirable figures of 0-3 off 1 over... Potential, he thought! Cam took over as captain in one game and was also called up to 1st grade this year. Thanks for your help this year 'Dog'!

Paddy 'Mount' Lindorff played the all-rounder role this year, opening the bowling and being an extremely useful middle order bat. Although plagued with a number of injuries he was a very good bowler for us. He often was just too good for the batsman with his leg cutters at good pace. Made a number of starts with the bat, but needs to keep his head down for another five to ten overs before unleashing his immense hitting power. Has the potential to be a future leader of the club, and was definitely a sounding board for myself.

John Brown 'Clown' also played the all-rounder role this year, bowling first change and batting in the top order for the majority of the year. 'Brown Clown' has all the attributes to be a classy top order batsman who should be pushing for 1^{st} grade selection. Like Paddy, really needs to knuckle down when he gets to 15-20 and go on. Made a couple of good scores of 38 and 44, but as I said should really go on from there. 'Clown' was a very valuable right arm outswing medium pacer, with another string to his bow, he is also a very handy legspin bowler. I would love to see him develop this art, as I believe this is something 2^{nd} grade is missing.

John 'Chucky' Gallagher last season and earlier this season seemed to bounce between grades, however later this year with his solid early season batting form and lightening fielding in at short leg cemented a place in second grade by season end. 'Chuck' showed his talents as a leg spinner (once he got his run up right), and with a little work (Oldy!) and consistency could become quite valuable when looking to mix it up. Another young buck that is a valued member of the 2nd Grade outfit. His knowledge of opposition bats was invaluable this season.

Brett 'Spriggy' Sprigg... What can one say about young Brett? I truly believe that given a few years this 'kid' will be in the 'Mark Holt' mould and an extremely valuable contributor to the East Fremantle Cricket Club. Brett stepped up into 2nd grade this year and I believe learnt a lot about the length he needs to bowl. As a bat, well that leaves a lot to be desired, however he did share in a 32 run partnership with 'Hef" Norcross, making 14 valuable runs himself. I look forward to watching him develop over the years to come.

Joel 'Billy' Mouritz was our regular gloveman for the year and was as solid as ever. Rarely fumbling, Billy was a great team man in every game he played taking 17 catches in 10 games. Would be great to see Billy training hard as I believe with a little effort he would become a very successful middle order bat and an even better keeper.

Aidan 'Beak' McCarton joined us from NSW this season (thanks to Badger and Bainesy). This kid is a talented gloveman worthy of a 1st grade keeping spot, if available. He is also extremely handy when in the field, and as a middle order bat, who has the technique to open. Took a while to settle on the synthetic pitches, however with better shot selection and more experience on this surface, he will become a prolific bat in either grade.

Nick 'Nikko' Macek gave us an extra dimension this year, by being a good middle order bat, averaging 20.18 and a handy medium pace bowler (especially in One-day cricket). At 5/23 in our final game with a finals berth at stake, he stood up and made 72 out of 142. We then defended this by 6 runs. Some of Nikko's fielding efforts this season were unbelievable, definitely the best fielder in the team, possibly the grade. 'Nikko' could be anything if he committed and trained. I seriously hope to see him next season playing for East Fremantle!

Matt 'Grooma' Groom is one of the young bucks we should be looking at to shape our clubs future with. 'Grooma' is a very down-to-earth easy-going lad with immense technical talent as a bat, and in the field. He bounced a little between grades this season, and suffered a lack of opportunities in second grade early. Like all good players when he dropped

back a grade from all reports he made a stylish half-century. This boy has talent! I believe he will become a regular second grade contributor next season, with higher honours beckoning!

Patty 'Liberty' Vallence was unfortunately severely hampered this year after breaking his ankle prior to the season beginning (these things happen when doing backflips off house roofs). He stood up at times for us, making some fighting runs against Riverton-Rostrata late in the season. An immense talent that when right, will play first grade.

Hugh 'Hef' Norcross is a prime example that if you work hard you will achieve results. Hef trained hard this year playing the first couple of games with seconds taking figures of 5-54 and 5-82 before being promoted to first grade where he continued to excel. He shared in that great partnership with Spriggy as well, making 18 not out.

Andrew 'Stevo' Stephen... Another high quality youngster! 'Stevo' always put the HIGHEST price on his wicket, knowing that runs will come, something I truly admired this year. He averaged 35.8 from his 6 innings, and added a little grit to our top order when available. We missed him when footy called. Achieved the acclaim he deserved by getting promoted into first grade this year.

Thomas 'Cooky' Cook was the life of the team when out on the field. Keeping the whole team up, focused and truly enjoying their cricket, 'Cooky' was a very important part of our mid-season turn around. A very flexible bat, averaging 23, with the ability to either open or bat in our middle order, he also could come on and bowl some handy medium pacers.

Other lads that contributed to the 2^{nd} grade season included **Brent 'Bully' Fairhead** who started the season in a blaze of glory, knocking up 3 half centuries in as many games which then saw him return to 1^{st} grade for the remainder of the season. (He averaged 43.6 from 5 innings). **Craig 'Coley' Cole** as one of the most destructive bats in the competition was unfortunately hampered by having to work away this season. He made a number of blistering scores this season, especially against Willetton in which his first 7 scoring shots were 6 - 2 - 6 - 6 - 6 - 4 - 4 (34 runs) going on to make 82.

One of our youngsters, **Sam Brown** had minimal opportunity in 2nd grade however showed enough with the bat and ball that suggests with a little work he will become a handy all rounder for us. And finally, **Scott 'Knighta' Knight** probably had a disappointing season after taking out the club's 2nd side Best & Fairest last year, however he contributed 100%, on and off the field. Bowled a couple of very handy spells during the year and I have no doubt he will come back with a vengeance next season. Would love to see him cement a spot in 2nd's next season.

Many thanks should also go to a couple of elder statesman of the club **Victor 'Borat' Kostopoulos**, **Mark 'Holty' Holt** and **Kevin 'Wobbler' Munro**. These lads filled in beautifully for us at different stages this year, with 'Holty' taking 4/45 when the pressure was on in what turned out to be our final game.

All in all a very enjoyable season with many highlights, unfortunately at this time of year when you don't make the finals, that's what sticks in your mind. However we can't dwell, next season will tell us how much we've learnt from this year's disappointment. So to finish on a high a few of my personal highlights included:

• **'Brown Dog's'** commando roll during celebrations following his great (& match winning) catch in our final game.

- 'Coley's' massive strike against Willetton. From the river end at Preston, he dispatched the ball onto the road behind the practice nets.
- And finally, 'Cookys' on field commentary, with so many memorable calls however "CHEEEEEEES!" and "FIIISH.... mmmm Protein!" spring to mind.

Congratulations must go to 1st, 5th and One day A's for their finals appearances this year. **Extremely well deserved!**

I'd like to thank a few people for the season that's passed, namely:

- 'Reggie' for his words of wisdom and support as President;
- **Darren 'Doggie' Muir** as chairman of selectors, I won't miss our Saturday morning phone calls!
- 'Brown Dog' for sorting out ball fees etc. every week, and along with 'Mount Lindorff' being a good leader out on the field, it is a team game after all;
- **'Spriggy'** for offering to be first square leg every week (although after the final game he has been sacked!); and finally
- To each and every one of the lads who lined up for East Fremantle CC 2nd XI this year, it was a pleasure!

Good luck to everyone in the coming months and next season. I hope to see every one of you back here next year, we have so much unfinished business!

In the batting department this year we had only 3 players scoring over 200 runs, and there were none better then the veteran **John Olczyk** who amassed 731 runs at an excellent average of 48.73 (including 3 centuries and a personal best career score of 170 vs Riverton Rostrata). It was a shame Olly pulled a hamstring on a couple of occasions, which kept him out of a few matches, however the thing I like about his batting is his running between wickets and his ability to turn the strike over on a regular basis. Well done Olly!!!

Vic Kostopoulos had another consistent season scoring 335 runs @ 25.77 and another veteran in **Kevin Munro** regained some of the form that we have come to expect from him over the years, scoring 235 runs @ 18.08. Both Kevin and Victor formed a dependable opening partnership combination for most of the season. Kevin also scored one century Vs Cockburn. Others to perform well with the bat were **Mark Bogensperger** 188 runs @ 17.09, **Daren Muir** 187 @ 31.17 & **Brodie Renouf** 167 @ an excellent average of 41.75

from only four innings. It was just a shame that due to work & family commitments we couldn't get Brodie playing on a more regular basis. He showed his class under finals pressure in the semi, making the highest score of 41 out of a paltry team total of 106. Was unfortunate when out to an excellent catch.

Other players to score half centuries were **Cam Brown** (51*), **John Gallagher** (73). **Tommy Cook** (63), **Jarrad Holt** (61), **Matt Groom** (54).

Bowling

A total of 21 bowlers were used during the year and the pick of the bowlers was **Gary Moustoukas.** Like a fine red Gary just keeps better and wiser with age. Gary took a staggering 48 wkts @ a miserly average of 6.92. This included 6 five wicket hauls and also 1 ten wicket haul in a match. What a sensational season Gazza!!

When I threw Gary the ball I always knew there would be action and he never let me down. The great trademark of Gary's bowling is his concentration and thinking abilities. He quickly works out a batsmen's weakness and then utilises his vast array of delivery types in his repertoire, to wreak havoc in opposition batting line-ups.

Mark Bogensperger also had a sensational year with the ball taking 44 wkts @ 10.32, including 3 five wicket hauls. The thing I like about Bogey is he plays with a lot of passion and has an extremely high work rate. His late inswinger bowled many batsmen throughout the season, often catching them by surprise. Bowled with much greater accuracy this season and his results showed this.

The only other bowler to take a 5 wkt haul was Nic Macek Vs Maddington.

Fielding

Wicket keeping is a difficult job at the best of times but particularly more so when you open the batting and you're no spring chicken!! For this reason **Kevin Munro** had an outstanding season behind the stumps taking 16 catches and affecting a very high rate of 10 stumpings. Others to break double figures were **Mark Bogensperger** with 11 catches and **Vic Kostopoulos** with 10.

One-Day Grand Final

At the end of the one day series we were positioned second on the ladder which earned us the right to play Armadale in the GF at Gwynne Park on Sunday 21 Jan. The only good thing about playing out there is the bus trip which turned out to be a most enjoyable trip home!!!!

After winning the toss I elected to bat first and we got away to a flier with the dynamic duo **Vic Kostopoulos** and **Kev Munro (18 including one towering 6)** setting up a great foundation with an opening partnership of 62. From there things went terribly wrong when we lost the next 5 wickets for only 13 runs, and at 6 for 75 things were looking very shaky to say the least.

A seventh wicket partnership of 25 between Bogey & Vic restored some credibility, however when the eighth wicket fell at 103 (Vic Kostopoulos) it put a shudder through the camp as Vic looked like he was set for a 100. Vic played his best innings for the season with a brilliant 75 (6 \times 4's), and what a time to play it. Vic stood strong throughout most of the innings only to see 7 wickets fall at the other end during his time at the crease. From the start he timed the ball well and it was an innings full of sheer determination and concentration, where he played shots to all parts of the ground.

Benny Campbell was the ninth wicket to fall when the score was on 113. Enter Gary Moustoukas (21*) & Scotty Knight (11) as the East Fremantle fighting spirit kicked in and "Moushy" and "Knighta" put on a most valuable last wicket stand of 34 to give us a defendable total of 147 to bowl at, even though we failed by 2 overs to bat out our 40. A great rearguard action considering we were 6 for 75 and the 100 was looking shaky there for a while.

I have always been a great believer (particularly in finals) that it's easier to defend than chase, and defend we did. At no stage did we allow Armadale to establish a sizable partnership, and it speaks volumes that their best partnership of 23 was their 10th wicket. All bowlers did a superb job, and **Gary Moustoukas** followed up on his fine batting display to finish with the great figures of 5/13 from 7 overs. He was well supported by **Mark Bogensperger** who returned 3/28 from his 8 overs. **Scotty Knight** started the rot with the all important wicket of Crabb and finished with 1/16 from 4 overs.

I suppose it would be remiss of me not to report my direct hit run out from mid wicket to remove one of Armadale's form and danger bats in Peter Smith, who I set myself to target in pre-match strategies. Needless to say I was planning that be with the ball and not with my fielding skills, but nonetheless it was a big wicket that was a turning point in the game, as I do believe at this time (5/56) the nerves and panic were beginning to show in the Armadale camp, as nothing was going to stop the Blue & White train.

The next 4 wickets fell for only 15 runs and as always the last wicket hung around for a while prolonging the agony for Armadale. But when Moushy deservedly took the last wicket Armadale were all out for 93 in just 30 overs as we comfortably won another one day flag.

We had a sensational bus trip back home and celebrated long and hard..... as winners do!!!!
