## **CAPTAIN'S REPORT 6A's**

Welcome players, life members and supporters. Firstly congratulations to all grades on a highly successful season.

I would like to thank all those (40) players who took part in games for 6As this year. It is always hard to manage the lowest grade (6Bs are untouchables) at the club. At the start of the summer I thought after last season's late run for the finals this could be our year. History shows it was unkind with only 7 wins. The loss of Bloodnut(moved to Midland), a knee injury to Greg Howard, Knowlesy not playing and a bad year with the bat by myself and Mick Curven didn't help.

Our squad this year included a high caliber of seasonal cricketers – Swifty, Beaker, Mick Shorter, the Howie Brothers, Curven, Half-Penny, Crossy and Roo McKinley. The problem was we couldn't get everyone together in the one game (lucky for the opposition). With an over-supply of players it was hard to juggle numbers and be successful. There was an average of six changes to the team each week, as I endeavored to give everyone a go, with selection priority to those who trained. Of course it is hard to please all and some guys didn't like the rotation system. I really struggled one week when 8 players missed out on selection and they all trained. It was the hardest night for me as a captain and the worst feeling I've ever had at the club, as I knew some would be bitterly disappointed. We're not playing for sheep stations, all I ask is that those on the paddock give 100% and I'm really happy they did.

Our batting did struggle compared to last season. Before Christmas we averaged runs per innings (5 wins, 4<sup>th</sup> position) and after chrissy we crashed with an average of only 130 runs (2 wins). The pick of our batters were Mick (the puller) Shorter with 330 runs, Graeme (the straight hitting) Howard 291 runs and Phil (the cutter) Swift with 248 runs. Bruce Penny and Vince Cross also had good years with the bat.

Bowling this year was our strength but our catching let us down; hence we couldn't finish sides off. The performances of our regular openers Bruce (1/2) Penny with 29 wickets @ 18.17 and Vince (he's not angry, he's) Cross 20 @ 19 was nothing short of first class. They formed one of the best opening bowling attacks in the competition. Good back-up came from C. McKinley, G. O'Brien, C. Willis and Graeme Howard. A special mention for Matt O'Brien who improved in each of his 6 games at the end of the season, taking 12 wkts @ 12.75. Matt is the most promising young strike bowler I have seen. He has a big heart, his fast ball is as quick as anyone's and being a lefty makes him hard for most batsmen to handle. Next season I would like to see some of the more experienced bowlers take him under their wings; work on his run up and control as I feel he has the potential to be a top line bowler for the higher grades in the future years.

It was great to see new players in 6A's this year including the O'Brien brothers, Frank Seamen and Dave (the Eurythmics) Stewart. Also well done Cass Willis on your return to the club, you bowled magnificently in 3 grades this year.

Thanks also to Howie, Swifty, and Curven for captaining in my absence and Brett Magee who captained when I captained (but you get that with Bobby).

Howie getting another ton after years of waiting and his 300<sup>th</sup> wicket

Vassy's game against Maddington, 8 overs 1/31 and 26 N.O. The best ever game I have ever seen him play! I've seen a few.

Frank Seamen giving 100% every time he played
The 'Black Arse Cod' showing some emotion at the vote night

Ken Judge appealed at the umpire (a real umpire; well supposedly) so loud and viciously he finally put up the finger. Howie couldn't believe it.
