Winthrop Australia First Grade Report

Unfortunately, our First Grade Skipper Scooter was unable to provide a Captain's Report. Thus, the editor will do his best to take on the reigns...

Holistically, the feeling within the First-Grade cohort was that we underdelivered in the 2025/26 season. The off-season seemed promising, with Scooter stepping-up into the Captaincy role and new keeper-batsman Tom Balkwill joining the group. We also had 2 Englishmen join our ranks over the season in Charlie Neville & Tim Smith, which strengthened both the batting & spin-bowling depths. Despite enhancing our talent, the team's post-season reflections gleaned that collective team standards, complacency, and in-game concentration hurt our on-field performances.

After a washout in Round 1, the team got off to decent start with wins against CBC, Leeming and Hilton Bicton. However, in all games there was a consistent theme of the side producing 30-60 minute lapses where we struggled to control momentum. This came back to bite after a tight loss to Cockburn where a collapse of 8/31 saw us fall 12 runs short in the One Dayer. The One Day fixtures were wrapped up with a streaky victory over a gallant SJ Blues, and then a blasting from Phoenix in a must-win match. The One Day season ended with us missing the finals by 0.55 points despite, arguably, never playing close to our best.

That said, there were some shining lights over the One Day fixtures. Jim Allenby amassed 228 runs at 45.6 & Haydan Morton 209, which included a wicked innings of 129 against CBC. Morts also took 10 wickets at 16, well supported by Cam Watson with 9 at 19.9 and Dane Johnston snaring 9 as well.

Towards the end of November the 2-day competition took over. We were dominant against the newly promoted Willetton Crows, scoring 4/317 and skittling them for 133. This was followed by a flattening outing against CBC where we failed to capitalise on strongholds in the game in both our bowling & batting innings. From 8/128 CBC managed to score 195, then the following week we collapsed from 1/99 to 10/131, beaten by a short-ball bowling barrage. Another strong performance against Leeming was then undone by an embarrassing display against bottom-of-the-ladder Hilton Bicton. Passive batting/bowling periods, wickets falling in clumps, or players repeatedly making decision making blunders all held us back from being a ruthless team.

The final three games of the season had us in the position to finish either 1st or 6th on the ladder, with difficult games against top 4 contenders ahead. At Davilak Reserve against Cockburn it was a workman-like effort that saw us grind out victory, rolling them for 169, being 2/40ish overnight and then completing the run chase 7-down in the 67th over. Playing SJ Blues we scored about par at home with 228, then bowled SJ for 178. The final round of the season saw us play Phoenix at Tempest in a one-day match with two-day rules...whatever the hell that's meant to be!?! We batted first and only managed 165, losing 4/0 in the final 3 overs. Phoenix were in a healthy position during their chase at 2/114, yet we grounded out victory again, keeping them to 9/162 from their 40 overs.

In a season where we may have only played at our best only two or three times over a 14-round season, we ended on the top of the table. The ladder shows that we scored 500 more runs than the competition's average, whilst runs conceded was about equal with the comp average – a solid effort given the Preston Point tax!

Yet in many ways, the Semi Final simply exposed what had been simmering beneath the surface all season. Despite finishing on top, we rarely produced complete performances with bat or ball, instead relying on moments of individual brilliance, favourable conditions, or our batting depth to paper over inconsistent cricket. The scoreboard and ladder suggested dominance, but internally many of us knew we had hardly put together the kind of disciplined, high-quality cricket needed to withstand finals pressure. When we hosted Cockburn at Preston for the Semi, they posted a competitive but manageable 213. Sadly we were confronted with the same shortcomings that had appeared throughout the year — and this time there was no escaping them. We were skittled for 148. Hardly an isolated collapse, but a reflection of a season where our results often flattered the standard of our performances.

Our key performers for the season are highlighted in the tables below, though a special mention is due to Jim Allenby for his exceptional consistency as the backbone of the batting order. Jim compiled 470 runs at 47, including five scores above 50, with many innings shaped by his willingness to bat for the match situation rather than personal milestones. Similarly, Haydan produced another outstanding season with the ball, claiming 34 wickets at 15.2, including three five-wicket hauls. His late-season switch to seam-up has certainly left a few of us wondering whether it becomes a permanent feature of the attack next year. Luke Strnadica, Tom Balkwill, Ben Scotson and Dane Johnston also made valuable contributions throughout the summer.

Despite some underwhelming performances on the field, it's difficult to overlook how enjoyable the summer was off it. As a sporadic-at-best fill-in for the First-Grade side, it was one of those years where being around the group felt good! Whether it was giving Tim and Charlie grief for another embarrassing English Ashes display, watching Callum nail ramp shots for six after sulking about his massive River Cruise hangover all day, or enduring Morts' unsolicited AI photo edits, the boys always found ways to make long Saturdays enjoyable.

That said, the challenge moving forward is to match that same energy, connection and enthusiasm with higher standards on the field. There's enough talent in this group to achieve far more than we showed this season — and it feels like the winds of change are about to start blowing.

Shelford Homes One Day B Report

The One Day B side wrapped up a strong after Xmas campaign this season to finish 4th on the ladder and qualifying for finals - a solid achievement in what proved to be a challenging season. The team consistently competed hard each week and built momentum through the middle part of the season to secure a place in the finals.

We finished the home and away season in fourth position, earning the opportunity to play in the first elimination final. Whilst we fell just short in that final, the season should still be viewed as a positive step forward for the group with several players improving as the year progressed.

Across the campaign there were several standout performances with both bat and ball, with contributions coming from across the team rather than relying on just one or two players. That balance proved important in getting the side into finals contention.

Batting Highlights

The batting lineup was led superbly by Brodie Renouf, who finished the season as the team's leading run scorer with an outstanding 407 runs at an average of 67.83. Brodie's consistency at the top of the order provided the backbone for several strong innings throughout the season and he only played half the season....

Close behind was Neil Mullally, who also had a strong campaign scoring 378 runs at 31.50, anchoring several key innings and building important partnerships.

Other strong contributors with the bat included:

- Samuel Kelsey – 268 runs at 19.86
- Logan Renouf – 258 runs at 36.86
- Cody Renouf – 205 runs at 51.25

Valuable contributions also came from:

- Declan Davidson – 120 runs
- Trenn Ritchie – 101 runs

The depth across the batting order ensured we regularly posted competitive totals and were able to recover from challenging positions throughout the season.

Bowling Performances

With the ball, Samuel Kelsey led the attack brilliantly, finishing the season as the club's leading wicket taker with 34 wickets at an impressive average of 18.79. His consistency and ability to strike regularly played a major role in several key victories.

Support came from Michael Carmody, who delivered an outstanding season taking 23 wickets at an exceptional average of 14.39, providing reliability and pressure through the middle overs.

Other key contributors included:

The spread of wickets across the team demonstrated the depth of the bowling attack and ensured East Fremantle remained competitive in most matches throughout the season.

From an all-round perspective congrats to Sam Kelsey who has had a fantastic year with bat, ball, fielding and captaincy.

Reaching finals cricket is always the goal, and while the team would have loved to progress further, the experience gained from playing finals will only strengthen the squad moving forward. Importantly, the One Day B side continues to play an important role within the club by developing players, strengthening depth, and contributing to the strong culture of East Fremantle Cricket Club. With a strong core group returning next season, the team will be looking to build on this year's effort and push even further up the ladder.

Congratulations to all players, supporters and volunteers on a successful season and a special shout out to Sam Kelsey and Michael Carmody who's friendship to me personally over the last 4 years has been exceptional and not a day of enjoyment was lost on me with the success we had. To Trenn and Murray Eastaugh 35-year friendships never disappear, and I thank you both for everything but unfortunately the body and mind are not playing nicely and it's a good time for me to pull stumps on a great time playing with EFCC on a regular basis.

Design Financial Advisory One Day E Report
